

Environmental Analysis

Macomb County, in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is conducting an environmental analysis in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) to evaluate the project's potential impacts to the social, cultural, and natural environment.

Environmental Class of Action

A Categorical Exclusion (CE) is being prepared because the project is not expected to individually or cumulatively have a significant environmental impact.

Environmental Study Area

The study area for the environmental analysis includes the Macomb County public right of way between 10 Mile Road and M-59. Construction limits will fall within the study area but have not yet been defined.

The project will remain within the existing public right of way and will not displace any residences or businesses.
